## **Market Analysis Week 7**

Region: Russian River, Azov / Black Sea, Caspian

Trade: Coaster shipments

Most grain Traders are still complaining about dull commodity market and low buyers' price idea. Notwithstanding the ongoing and quite prolonged idle time of tonnage employed in Azov's and Black Sea areas, supported by severe ice conditions, freight rates have suffered almost no change.

Those Charterers who endeavor to execute shipment these days, are facing problems with port silos in Azov Sea, which tend to receive cargo quite poorly due to unfavorable weather conditions.

Authorities of port Temryuk have officially cancelled ice campaign, effecting from 20 of February. Several Black Sea ports, namely Nikolayev and Kherson are soon to follow, with expected dates of 5 of March.

Overall, as Charterers expect, from the beginning of March freight rates may start decline, owing to low sales caused by currency rates instability.

Region: Baltic / ARAG

Trade: Coaster shipments, Handy-size

Coaster market in Baltic region goes up freight-wise, due to notable lack of spot/prompt tonnage and even worse – most Ship Owners are reluctant to employ their fleet there.

Much tonnage gathered up in ARAG region, both coasters and Handy. While it is relatively easy for the Charterers to find suitable vessel, rates have endured so far. In case this trend shall continue, we expect rates to drop within next week.
